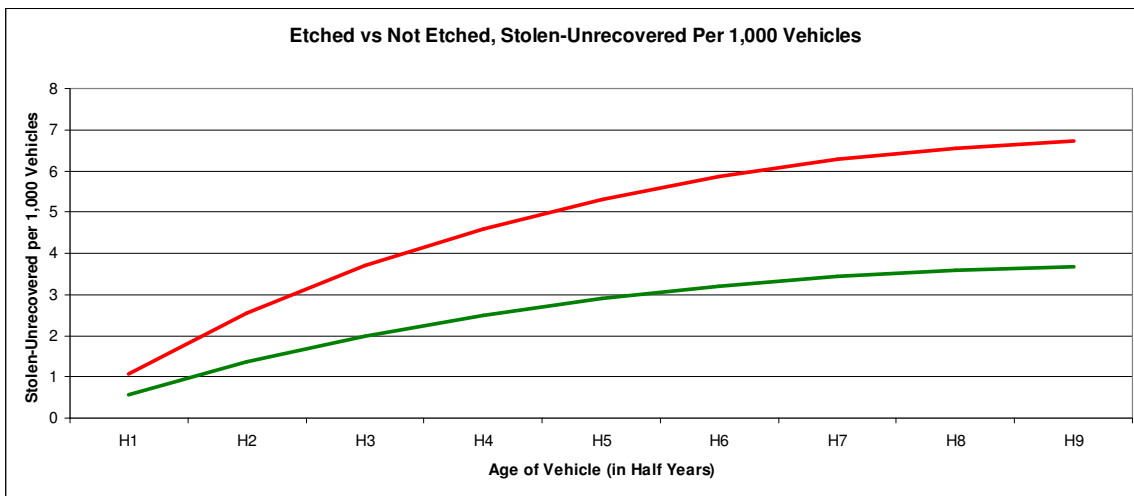


RETAINAGROUP CELEBRATES A 'FIRST' WITH THATCHAM ACCREDITATION
